Sodium Chloride injection	limited to use in combination with Heparin lock flush solution for flushing intravenous equipment
Somatropin (rDNA origin) (SEROSTIM)	restricted to use in the treatment of pts wasting from AIDS or with AIDS associated cachexia. Brand name Serostim is the only formulation covered, and maximum therapy of 12 weeks is allowed, after which an 8 week break in therapy needs to occur before resuming
Stavudine (ZERIT)	restricted to use in the treatment of HIV disease
Sumatriptan Succinate (IMITREX)	limits on amounts as follows: 1) injections—max of 2 injections/dispensing with a limit of 10 dispensings per year (any 12 month period) 2) tablets—max of 9 pills/dispensing and a limit of 3 dispensings per year 3) nasal spray—max of 6 spray containers per dispensing and a limit of 3 dispensings per year
Tazarotene (TAZORAC)	restricted to use in the treatment of Psoriasis
Tretinoin Cream (RETIN-A)	for use in acne
Valacyclovir HCl (VALTREX)	restricted to use in genital Herpes (HS II) and shingles (Herpes Zoster)
Valganciclovir HCL (CYMEVAZ)	restricted to use in the treatment of AIDS & AIDS-related conditions
Vitamins ADC with or without Fluoride or Iron (TRI-VI-SOL, VI-DAYLIN)	limited to use in children < 5 years of age
Zalcitabine (HIVID)	restricted to use in the treatment of HIV disease
Zaleplon (SONATA)	restricted to use in the treatment of insomnia
Zanamivir (RELENZA)	restricted to use in the treatment of acute illness (< 2 days duration of symptoms) due to Influenza virus in pts at high risk of complications from influenza. limited to 1 kit/dispensing and 3 dispensings per 6 month period. A TAR is required if intended use is for the prevention of influenza after exposure.
Zidovudine (RETROVIR, AZT)	restricted to use in the treatment of HIV disease
