



# SANTA BARBARA REGIONAL HEALTH AUTHORITY FORMULARY LIST AND CODE 1 DEFINITIONS OF RESTRICTIONS

Effective March 2003

The Health Authority mandates generic substitution when an “AB” rated equivalent generic product is available. Generally if a prescriber wants a brand name drug and designates *Do Not Substitute* on the prescription, then a MRF must also be submitted explaining why a brand name drug is required.

Prescription quantities should not exceed a 30-day supply of medication unless specified as an exception to this rule. On the following pages, drugs that must be dispensed as a 100-units and are an exception to the 30-day supply rule are indicated by a #.

If the medication listed comes in more than one formulation, the 100-quantity limit applies only to the tablet or capsules and not to liquid formulations.
