

Quality Care Incentive Program Measures

Behavioral Health

1. Antidepressant Medication Management - Acute Treatment: the percentage of members aged 18 and older who were diagnosed with major depression and remained on an antidepressant for at least 12 weeks.
2. Antidepressant Medication Management - Continuing Treatment: the percentage of members aged 18 and older who were diagnosed with major depression and remained on an antidepressant for at least 6 months.
3. Avoidance of Opioids at a High Dosage: the percentage of members who were prescribed two or more opioids on different dates that had less than 15 days of total opioid prescription coverage.

Women's Health

1. Breast Cancer Screening: the number of female members aged 52-74 who've received a screening mammogram in the last 24 months.
2. Cervical Cancer Screening: the number of female members aged 24-64 who've received appropriate cervical cancer screening in the last 36 or 60 months.
3. Chlamydia Screening in Women: the number of women ages 16-24 who are sexually active and have been screened for chlamydia in the last 12 months.

Pediatric Care

1. Immunizations for Adolescents: the number of adolescents who've received at least 1 Tdap, 1 Meningococcal, and at least 2 HPV vaccines before their 13th birthday.
2. Well Child Visits in the First Thirty Months of Life: the number of children who've had the following:
 - a. Six or more well-child visits before their 15th month of age.
 - b. Two or more well-child visits before their 30th month of age.
3. Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits: the number of children aged 3-21 who had at least one well-care visit during the last 12 months.
4. Lead Screening in Children: the number of children who had at least one blood lead screening test before their 2nd birthday
5. Childhood Immunization Status - Influenza: the number of children who've received at least 2 influenza vaccines before their 2nd birthday.

Diabetes Care

1. HbA1c Testing: the number of diabetic members who've received an HbA1c test in the last twelve months.
2. Retinal Eye Exams: the number of diabetic members who've had a retinal or dilated eye exam by an optometrist or ophthalmologist in the last 12 months or a negative retinal or dilated eye exam in the last 24 months.
3. Statin Therapy for Patients with Diabetes - Received Statin Therapy: the percentage of members aged 40-75 with diabetes who were dispensed at least one statin medication during the year.
4. Therapy for Patients with Diabetes - Statin Adherence 80%: the percentage of members aged 40-75 with diabetes who remained on a statin medication for at least 80% of the treatment period.

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Respiratory Care

1. Asthma Medication Ratio: the number of asthmatic members who have a ratio of filled controller asthma medications to total asthma medication fills of 50% or more in the last 12 months.
2. Pharmacotherapy Management of COPD Exacerbation Bronchodilator: the percentage of members with COPD 40 and older who had an ED visit and were dispensed a bronchodilator.
3. Pharmacotherapy Management of COPD Exacerbation Systemic Corticosteroid: the percentage of members with COPD 40 and older who had an ED visit and were dispensed a systemic corticosteroid.

Cardiac Care

1. Statin Therapy for Patients with Cardiovascular Disease - Received Statin Therapy: the percentage of male members aged 21-75 and female members aged 40-75 with cardiovascular disease who were dispensed at least one high or moderate intensity statin medication.
2. Statin Therapy for Patients with Cardiovascular Disease - Statin Adherence 80%: the percentage of male members aged 21-75 and female members aged 40-75 with cardiovascular disease who remained on a high or moderate intensity statin medication for at least 80% of the treatment period.
