Call Script to Advocate for Medicaid:

1. Hello, my name is [Your Name] and I am a constituent of [Your City/Zip Code]. I am calling to speak with [Senator's Name] regarding Medicaid.
2. I am contacting you today to express my strong opposition to the "One Big Beautiful Bill Act" and any other proposed cuts or changes to Medicaid that will negatively impact millions of beneficiaries and state budgets nationwide.
3. [Share your position on Medicaid. Below are some examples]
 - "Medicaid is a lifeline for so many people in our community, including low-income individuals, children, seniors, and those with disabilities. It provides essential health coverage, including long-term care, mental health services, and preventive care."
 - "Cutting or limiting Medicaid would have devastating consequences for our state, leaving many without the care they need to stay healthy and productive."
 - "It's not just about healthcare; it's about supporting families, keeping people out of hospitals and nursing homes, and promoting economic stability."
4. [Share your personal experience with receiving services funded by Medicaid. Below are some examples of what you may want to discuss]
 - What services do you receive through Medicaid funding.
 - What do these services help you to do.
 - What the impact of not having those services means for your life and for your family's lives.
5. I urge [Senator's Name] to vote no on the "One Big Beautiful Bill Act" and any other reconciliation proposals that would cut Medicaid.
